Benefits for teachers





YEAR 8 Cyber Fraud Challenge – Friday 13 May:

70 enthusiastic and determined Year 8 “Cyber Engineers” at MES were led by a representative from Thales and Smallpeice – the Education Charity - in a ‘Cyber Fraud Challenge’. Students learned the importance of protecting customers data and detecting cyber weaknesses through ethical hacking. We definitely have some future Cyber Security and Computer experts here!

YEAR 9 Careers Inspiration Day - Friday 17 June

Students immersed themselves in 5 career sectors through research and engaging with employer representatives from Microsoft, Thales, Red10, Covea Insurance & Thames Water . Students also created some presentations for which house points were awarded to those whose presentations were especially strong and powerful. Some students also enjoyed the opportunity to create and present an 'Enterprise Project' - showcasing their creative & planning skills, as well as business acumen!

YEAR 7 Ozobots Challenge – Thursday 23 June

Thales returned to lead a group of Year 7 in using ‘Ozobots’. Working in pairs the students learned to code using pens containing special ink to control their robot. It was a fascinating day!

YEAR 9 Spotlight on Skills Sessions – Thursday 23 June

Thales worked with our Year 9 students who will learn about and develop skills for the workplace. Through taking part in a teambuilding exercise and learning about ‘A Day in the Life of an Engineer’ – students will have the opportunity to discuss the skills required for the exercise and to be an engineer.

YEAR 10 Work Shadow Day - Friday 24 June

MES Students in Year 10 had some fantastic placements arranged at local and more distant companies & organisations. Spending a day in the workplace was an exciting and key opportunity for them all.

YEAR 12 Future Pathways Day - Friday 24 June

Students took part in a fantastic Future Pathways event designed to help them make informed choices & decisions about their future at post 18. The day involved workshops & presentations from Barclays, Reading University, Henley Business School, and our UCAS coordinator and tutors on writing a personal statement for University applications.

YEAR 7 S.T.E.A.M. Day - Friday 1 July

Year 7 students thoroughly enjoyed participating in 4 STEAM related activities run by Covea Insurance, Thales and Thames Water. Activities included an 'Escape Room' and 'Bin it, don't block it'

Throughout the Trust schools – students and teachers have been using the fantastic resources created by **Miss Ryan at MER!** Topics included:


- Exploring careers and climate change and sustainability and hot topics such as:

A big 'Thank You' Mr Buck – you have done so very much for our careers provision and we are all extremely grateful.


