Due to the ongoing situation with COVID-19 preventing in-person work experience from taking place for the foreseeable future, we are encouraging all Year 12 students to consider completing some, if not all, of their work experience hours virtually.

Understandably, you may be worried about missing out on the experience of a real working environment. However, participating in online work experience has many benefits...



Unlike many in-person placements which have lengthy and competitive application processes, the majority of online placements do not require you to apply formally



Virtual work experience placements are usually free or much more cost-effective than those carried out in-person, since there are no travel or accomodation costs



Online placements are more convenient than in-person work experience opportunities as most can be completed at any time rather than during specific weeks

PATHWAYS INTO ART AND **DESIGN CAREERS**

It is worth noting that many artists and designers do not have a straightforward or conventional career pathway and often spend some, if not all, of their career doing freelance work. This calls for artists and designers to be businessminded and excellent communicators as well as creative in order to scout out potential opportunities and openings.



There are many general and more specialised apprenticeships related to art and design, such as graphic design, art therapy, and packaging design. Courses related to the creative arts are popular degree subjects and, similarly to the apprenticeship route, allow for greater or lesser degrees of specialisation.
